Ponder in Prayer: Rejoice in the extravagance of God, the way he goes above and beyond in meeting both physical and spiritual needs.

Day 3 – Read: John 4:1-42
Ponder in Prayer: Reflect on the transformation that occurred in this woman and in this community because Jesus chose to share water with an outcast.

Day 4 – Read: John 6:16-21; Luke 8:22-25; Matthew 28:20
Ponder in Prayer: Thank Jesus for the promise of his presence, and his power and authority in the midst of storms.

Day 5 – Read: John 13:1-17; Matthew 25:34-40
Ponder in Prayer: Choose someone and minister to them today, conveying your love to God, demonstrating that He has first place in your heart.
